



Dear Parents,

On **Monday, 3.10.2016** we are going to have our **Monday Ritual at 8 a.m.** on the basketball court. I would like to warmly welcome you to participate in the event.

As you know from the previous parents letters, the **team of inspectors , namely Mr. Knieling** (representative of Ministry of Education Abroad) **and Mrs. Drasdo** (Regional representative of the German Agency for Schools Abroad) are going to be in our school **from 10.10.-14.10.2016** for the German School Inspection.

The focus of the inspection is going to be on classes 1-10.

Not all parents were able to participate in the information meeting on the inspection which was held on the 25th of August 2016 in the lunch hall, I would therefore like to once more give you a brief summary.

The inspection is going to be based on the quality framework for German Schools Abroad.

The agenda will include first of all lesson observations, a rating conference with the teachers, interviews with the members of the school board, the head of school, the head of administration, the parents' representatives and pupils.

At the end the school will obtain a report which will contain a documentation of the results of the inspection.

With the help of the school facilitator, the school will then write a measures plan based on the report with the aim of developing the quality of the school.

The inspectors are going to introduce themselves, the contents and the procedures for the inspection in an **opening event on Monday, 10.10.2016 at 6 p.m in our lunch hall**. The entire school community is warmly welcome to participate and I would be delighted to see many of you honour this invitation. Also on **Friday, 14.10.2016 at 5 p.m. the closing event** is going to take

place during which the **first results of the inspection** are going to be presented to the entire school community. Those interested are warmly welcome to participate in this event.
